2. Bookkeeper's report, review investments and take appropriate action; approve payment of bills.
3. Conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy.
4. Accept and authorize filing of Disclosure Statement from Investment Officer and Bookkeeper.
5. Tax Assessor/Collector's report; approve payment of bills from tax account.
6. Delinquent tax attorney's report on collection status of delinquent taxes, and authorize any necessary action.
7. Operator's report, and take action as necessary.
8. Conduct hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts and take action, if appropriate.
9. Engineer's report and take action as necessary, including:
  - a. status of detention ponds and acceptance of maintenance by Harris County Precinct No. 4;
  - b. status of construction in Villages of Spring Oaks, Section 3;
  - c. status of Phase II of sanitary sewer rehabilitation in Birnamwood, Section III;
  - d. status of water well pump replacement;
  - e. status of water well improvements;
  - f. status of joint water well project;
  - g. status of construction plans for Breckenridge Forest, Section 8, within Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 82; and
  - h. status of Bond Application No. 6.
10. Developer's report and authorize any necessary action.
11. Report from Treschwig Joint Powers Board representative and take action, if appropriate.
12. Report from North Harris County Regional Water Authority representative and take action, if appropriate.
