

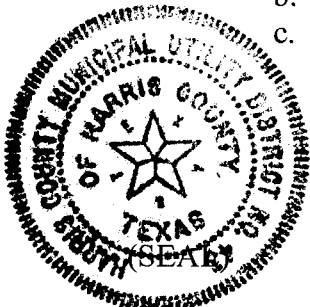



Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 43 of Harris County, Texas, will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **THURSDAY, JUNE 19, 2008, at 12:00 Noon**, at the offices of Vinson & Elkins L.L.P., 1001 Fannin Street, 25th Floor Conference Center, Houston, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Review and approve minutes of May 6 and 15, 2008, meetings.
2. Bookkeeper's report, review investments and take appropriate action; approve payment of bills.
3. Tax Assessor/Collector's report and approve payment of bills from tax account.
4. Delinquent Tax Attorney's report on collection status of delinquent taxes, and authorize any necessary action.
5. Operator's report and authorize any necessary action.
6. Conduct hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts and take action, if appropriate.
7. Engineer's report and take action as necessary, including:
 - a. status of sanitary sewer rehabilitation in Birnamwood, Section V;
 - b. interconnect agreement with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 82;
 - c. fencing for limiting access to drainage facilities; and
 - d. discuss Park Plan.
8. Developer's report and authorize any necessary action.
9. Report from Treschwig Joint Powers Board representative and take any necessary action, if appropriate.
10. Report from North Harris County Regional Water Authority representative and take action, if appropriate.
11. Consider insurance renewal proposals and take action as necessary.
12. Authorize attendance at Association of Water Board Directors' Summer Conference.
13. Discuss constable patrolling schedule.
14. Hear reports from Directors and take action as necessary.
15. General Counsel's Report and take action as necessary, including:
 - a. legal remedies for meter theft;
 - b. District improvements to HOA property; and
 - c. issuance of park bonds.
