1. Bookkeeper's report:
 - a. fund balances and disbursements;
 - b. payment of bills;
 - c. investments; and
 - d. proposed budget for fiscal year ending December 31, 2010.

2. Tax Assessor/Collector's report:
 - a. collections;
 - b. account balances;
 - c. disbursements; and
 - d. tax transfers.

5. Conduct hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts and take action, if appropriate.
6. Engineer's report:
 - a. fencing at intersection of Harris County Flood Control District easement and Hickorygate Drive;
 - b. discuss estimate for removal of dead trees from District properties;
 - c. discuss next step for Parks Master Plan; and
 - d. availability of Texas Parks and Wildlife grants for District parks projects.
