

Important Water Use Information

Harris County MUD No 43 is now in Stage 1 of our "Drought Contingency Plan"

We are, as of June 26, 2009 in the first stage of our Drought Contingency Plan
This means that everyone should voluntarily reduce water use or we could go into a more severe stage in our drought contingency plan very quickly.

Signs have been posted at our entrances

You are asked to water on specific days and at designated times.

If you live on the even side of the street (0,2,4,6,8), you are limited to outdoor water use on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday between midnight and 9:00am and 7:00pm and midnight

If you live on the odd side of the street (1,3,5,7,9), you are limited to outdoor water use on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday between midnight and 9:00am and 7:00pm and midnight

No Outdoor water use on Mondays

**Stage 2 of the plan uses the same days and times but there are many other restrictions and the ability to charge penalties & surcharges equal to 200% of the rate for water. and possible disconnection of service for repeat offenders.

Stage 2 Restrictions

1. All outdoor water use must be conducted with a hand held hose with a manual on-off nozzle. The use of sprinklers or an automatic sprinkler system is prohibited at all times.
2. Permitting water to accumulate or run in any gutter or street is a violation of this order.
3. The following public water uses not essential for public health and safety must be curtailed.
 - a. Washing down streets, sidewalks, walkways, driveways or other hard surfaced areas;
 - b. Use of water from Fire Hydrants other than fire fighting purposes
 - c. Filling of swimming pools, wading pools, spas, fountains and Jacuzzi type pools
 - d. Failure to repair a controllable leak within a reasonable period of time

If we all stay on the plan we will have all the water we need
